Gracie's Guardians • \$50,000

Supporting highly complex cases, Gracie's Guardians cover surgeries that require four or more procedures. Born with an ulcerated hemangioma, Gracie lost her ears and lips as a baby. After years of treatment, she's now eating, speaking, and brushing her teeth like a normal kid. As a Guardian, you'll help kids like Gracie access the life-changing care they need, providing comprehensive support for our most challenging cases. This tier covers multiple trips to and from New York City, extensive pre- and post-operative care, and accommodation for families during treatments.



Bjorn's Heroes • \$25,000



Bjorn's Heroes supports moderately complex cases, such as microtia patients who require three separate visits to New York. Bjorn was born with microtia, a congenital deformity that left him with an underdeveloped ear. After a long treatment journey spanning one year and three visits to New York, Bjorn can now hear thanks to his newly installed bone-anchored hearing aid. This tier covers surgeries that necessitate three to four doctor's visits, transport assistance for out-of-town patients, necessary pre- and post-operative care, and accommodation assistance for families.

Analeigha's Angels • \$10,000

Covering surgeries that require one to two doctor's visits, Analeigha's Angels supports cases where just one procedure can make a dramatic difference. In Analeigha's case, her eyesight was saved with one surgery that removed a hemangioma on her eyelid. This tier includes an initial consultation, one ten-day stay in New York, and little to no follow-up treatment required. Analeigha's Angels provide critical care that can have a life-changing impact with just one or two visits and a single surgery.
